Wonderful Waterfall

A TRIP TO INDONESIAN GIANT CURTAIN WATERFALL OF TUMPAK SEWU

Located in between Lumajang and Malang Districts, Tumpak Sewu waterfall boasts magnificent natural scenery. The distance, which is 66 kilometers from the city of Malang, East Java, can be easily reached. Indeed, travelers can access the waterfall with no fuss. A two-hour drive from the city, you can relish the magnificence of waterfall. It's not free as you have to pay Rp10,000 per person. Yet, trust me the beauty that will pamper your eyes is worth much more than the entrance fee.

Tumpak Sewu is derived from Javanese words: "Tumpak" and "Sewu", literally meaning flow and thousands, respectively. As the words

suggest, the scenery features waterfalls that are combined into the depiction of one giant curtain.

Not only beautiful, but Tumpak Sewu is also unique because it's very different from most of the waterfalls you can find in East Java, most of which are classified as plunge waterfall; it's the water was directly cascaded into the water below it. As for Tumpak Sewu, the waterfall is cascaded to directly hit the rocks beneath it. Here is where you can also see the astonishing rainbow form formed by the water splash.


Beautifully situated nearby Mount Semeru, Tumpak Sewu's upstream is located in the mountain and it streams down 14 kilometers to the waterfalls, delivering exceptionally fresh, clear and cool water. This site is indeed considered the pride of the nation, dubbed a doppelganger of Niagara Falls in Northern America.





Although the water discharge is not as much as what Niagara has, Tumpak Sewu still boasts heavenly magnificent natural scenery. Once you hike a little bit up the hill around the waterfalls, you will get a better picture of what the natural beauty is all about. In fact, photographers find this place a heavenly nature to shoot the scenery from various angles.

As you explore more, you will get the vibe of a supernatural nuance that results from the combined breathtaking views of Mount Semeru and Tumpak Sewu waterfall. Not only does it serve great landscape above the waterfall, but right there below the waterfall is also where the tremendous panorama that will freshen your eyes and mind. It's such a beautiful vista that takes travelers to witness the presence of wonderful waterfall soaring high up to 12 meters above the ground.



Besides boasting the exceptional landscape, Tumpak Sewu also offers a challenging trip for mount hikers. Surrounded by cliffs, the site is truly suitable for hiking tracks. The hiking paths are quite difficult to be forded. Hikers need to climb the cliffs through soft bamboo stairs; and in some places, travelers have to hold on to the rope. Those seeking a challenging adventure will undoubtedly find Tumpak Sewu a fun field to explore, even though they have to walk in the river to reach the most beautiful part of the waterfall area.

While you are there, you should also not miss visiting Tetes waterfall, which is located only 200 meters away from Tumpak Sewu waterfall. What makes this site interesting is the caves covered in stalagmites and stalactites on the cliff on the side of the waterfall.

NOT JUST A PICTURE-POSTCARD DESTINATION, THE HAGUE IN THE NETHERLANDS IS WHERE KINGSHIP AND GLOBAL JUSTICE SIT TOGETHER

To think of The Netherlands beyond Amsterdam might be a bit tricky for most people, including myself. So, when I decided to give The Hague a visit, I wasn't prepared for any surprises. The city itself is relatively small, with less than 550,000 people calling it home and one can practically walk from one end to the other less than a few hours. Those facts, however, may just be the reason why The Hague is an exemplary Dutch metropolis.

Honesty and Efficiency

Two of the most synonymous traits to a Dutchman are honesty and efficiency. The Hague is both: You can leave your

bike unattended somewhere in the city just to find it left untouched after a few days. This small city is after all home to the International Court Justice, where major judicial cases that involve multiple countries are settled here. Now, efficiency really regulates how the city works. Going around the city is very easy as everything seems huddled together. You can rent a bike or simply walk as each street has individual tracks for cars, bikes and pedestrians. Hopping on and off the tram is effortless; you are expected to obey the rules by tapping the transportation card when going in and out of the tram (hardly any authorities observing the citizens though). Likewise, supermarkets have personal check-out counters

where you scan goods yourself and pay individually. Unsurprisingly, the Dutch follow the rules to the dot.

Places to Go

1. CENTRUM

The city center is a must visit as you can find interesting histories regarding this powerful nation as well as appreciate the iconic monuments. You can walk around Binnenhof, where top meetings of Dutch government take place, and check out Mauritshuis Museum to see Vermeer's "Girl with a Pearl Earring" painting lives among other treasured works by Dutch artists. The Noordeinde Palace, one of the three royal palaces, is a few blocks away and is a nice place to take a selfie. There are beautiful churches nearby but, mind you, the Dutch are very frank regarding their views on religions and may invite you to a healthy argument.

2. HAAGSE BOS

A forest in the heart of the city is both inspiring and relaxing. Haagse Bos, literally meaning the forest of Den Haag, is perfect for an easy stroll alone or with the family. There are areas designated for kids, and there's even a palace well-guarded there. It also connects from one side of the city to another. It definitely induces a zen feel to a city life.

3. SCHEVENINGEN

As if a forest is not enough, The Hague also boasts Scheveningen Beach that is great during summertime. The white sandy area has a shopping center on one end, with plenty of tourist attractions for the whole family. Nonetheless, do not wander off too far as there is also a spot dedicated to the

nudists. And when you decide to have a picnic outside, always cover your food before any seagulls snatch your meal.

4. ESCHER MUSEUM AND GEMEENTEMUSEUM

For art fanatics, both Echer Museum and Gemeente museum are not to be missed. The first is located around the Centrum and boasts a wonderful collection of intriguing geometric works by M.C. Escher. The building itself is a historic object, once settled in by Prince Henry and Princess Marie in the 19th century. If you're more into Mondrian paintings, then Gemeente museum will sate your appetite since it houses the largest Mondrian collection in the world. You might spend not just one nor two, but roughly four hours to observe the artworks one by one. And the kids area on the basement is fascinating even for adults.

Notes

- Mastercard and visas might not be accepted in many places. So, always prepare some cash.
- Any bill bigger than €50 is hardly accepted, too.
- The Dutch love rules. Do not walk on the bicycle lane.
- Do not get offended by the Dutch's straightforwardness or humor. They rarely censor what they say.
- Be careful with wasps when dining out. They're everywhere.
- The city has plenty of Indonesian restaurants. And they're good, too!



To Post or Not to Post

WHILE HALF OF INDONESIANS ARE ON FACEBOOK NOW, LITTLE DID REALIZE HOW SOCIAL MEDIA ETIQUETTE CAN REALLY MAKE OR BREAK ONE'S CAREER

Social media is a defining evolution of the 21st century. With the global population of 7.7 billion people, it's impressive to note that Facebook had about 2.4 billion users in 2019, regardless of the authenticity of their identities. In Indonesia alone, it was estimated that 150 million Indonesians were on the social media in 2019, approximately 50 percent of the country's massive population. That social media use growth, however, has been poorly

accompanied by much-needed education on related policies and regulations. Ask a friend whether he or she has heard someone getting a problem in the workplace due to a social media post, the answer is often "yes." So, what is the social media etiquette we need to know and follow?

The Dos

1. HAVE A LINKEDIN

If you have a job, then you need one. Despite the popularity of Facebook in

Indonesia, only 14 million people have a LinkedIn account, let alone a well-maintained one. Does it really matter? Yes, because LinkedIn has officially become the world's largest professional network, and many recruiters rely on that to get the basic portfolio out of a candidate. In major countries like the UK, the top three social media platforms for job hunting according to Recruitment & Employment Confederation (REC) in 2019 are LinkedIn by 94 percent, Facebook by 47 percent and Twitter by 44 percent. So, if you have a LinkedIn, you'll be more easily connected; if you do have a well-maintained LinkedIn, you'll be more easily accepted.

2. SET YOUR PRIVACY SETTINGS CORRECTLY

You might not take the privacy setting seriously until something hits you. But for job hunting, that something might not even be noticeable since a lot of large enterprises are using apps to sort out of CVs and digital identities of potential candidates. San Francisco-based Jobvite is among the top names, and its survey back in 2012 already noted down several points where recruiters really frown upon a

candidate's portfolio: any mention of illegal drugs, sexual activities, profanity, grammar mistakes and pictures of him or her drinking. So, the best thing to do is to keep most things private when you don't even know what you already have published online.

3. GOOGLE YOUR NAME

Yes, you need to do that just to be aware of what strangers or recruiters perceive of you online. If you don't have much, then maybe it's time to build up your portfolio, through LinkedIn among others. If you have much but not solidly published yet, you can even try to publish it on Wikipedia. It's not easy, mind you, but it's not an impossible feat. You need to be an editor of 10 or more articles before able to ink your own name and portfolio online on that open site. In other words, you need to be search-able in this 21st century, no matter what.

4. KNOW THE RULES

Most Indonesians by now have heard about the Rules and Regulations on Online Information and Trade (UU ITE). Nonetheless, hardly anyone precisely remembers the details. You can easily go to hukumonline.com to look it up or ask any question pertaining to any online behavior. Complaining about your corrupted boss online? Even if that's true, you can be charged for a four-year imprisonment or a maximum fine of Rp750,000,000 due to defamation. In some rare cases like what happened at the army (TNI) in October 2019, there was a colonel who had to step down due to his wife's unhappy comments on the social media.

So, beware of what your spouse or close relatives share online, too.

The Don'ts

1. DO NOT HAVE ANY SOCIAL MEDIA ACCOUNT

While for those who are not millennial, life is much less complicated without non-ending notifications on who's liking your posts or whatsoever. Then again, when you have no social media accounts at all, you might be deemed slightly irrelevant to the current job market and recruiters. Jobvite's 2014 social recruiting survey listed down positions in relation to sales, operations and IT as the top three sought out through mobile online recruitment services. There have also been steady increases of 10 up to 14 percent from year to year since 2011 regarding the investment made by recruiters to involve online recruitment.

2. DO NOT BE FRIEND WITH EVERYONE

Like your boss, for instance. In countries like the US, there is so-called freedom of speech. Unfortunately, that might not be applicable in other places. So, what seems to be a personal space, like your own Facebook, is accountable to your superiors in the workplace. Of course, you cannot say no when your boss is inviting you to be friends with. You can otherwise select what to post or who can see your posts. Always remember: News travels fast, especially bad news. In today's terms, news goes viral fast, and it remains online quite possibly forever.

3. DO NOT HAVE TOO MANY ENDORSEMENTS

Some of you might just be budding influencers who'd like to grow your own brands through the social media. Many marketers might have worked

with you. That doesn't mean they're willing to let you into the company and join the team when you're looking for a stable corporate seat. As with any marketing trends, “influencer” has risen very rapidly that some marketers have seen not just the goods but also the bads. If you are thinking of working for a particular brand in the future, it's better for you to focus on that specific industry and curate whatever you post. Instead of agreeing to a variety of endorsements, stick to the ones that would be building bricks to your future career. The phrase “less is more” certainly rings true in this case.



4. DO NOT POST ANY OPINION ON SENSITIVE SUBJECTS

Although the government's UU ITE has drafted down several points on rules for online behavior considerable as crime, it's better for you to steer clear from expressing yourself on sensitive subjects online, such as politics, race, religion, etc. The reality is that no commercial company wants to employ an opinionated person online. A current case in point: Liu Yifei, main actress of “Mulan,” who spoke about her sentiment regarding the Hong Kong protest, which resulted in a boycott of that film in that city-state. If you're unsure of what is allowed to say or not online, you can submit a question to hukumonline.com before making a fool out of yourself. Even when what you intend nothing bad and do what seems to be only a good thing, online posts often get misinterpreted or misrepresented to recalibrate the meaning. Now-global singer Agnez Mo surely learned it the hard way end of last year. Then again, she had the clout to set things right again fast. What about you?


The Happy Prints




7. BRATISLAVA


